2014 Willamette Valley Pinot Gris

Signature White of Oregon: crisp, dry, and refreshing. The grapes are handpicked, hand-sorted and whole cluster pressed. Stainless steel fermentation for 2 weeks followed by sur lies aging for 3 months. 6,400 cases produced. 90 points WE.

2015 Dundee Hills Rose of Pinot Noir *SOLD OUT*

100% Estate Pinot Noir, Organically grown in the Dundee Hills. Handpicked, hand-sorted and whole cluster pressed. Fermented in stainless steel tanks and aged for two and half months. 4,900 cases produced. 2016 vintage release: Jan 2017

2013 Dundee Hills Pinot Noir

Fabulous Oregon vintage; elegant, age-worthy & food-friendly style Pinot Noir. The grapes are handpicked, hand-sorted and carefully destemmed. Made with 100% organically grown estate grapes. 100% barrel-aged in French Oak for 16 months, 31% new barrels. 9,700 cases produced. 89 Points WE & 88 Points WA. 2014 vintage release: Sept 2016.

Evolution Brut Sparkling Wine, Methode Champenoise

This is a Brut-style classic sparkling made from Evolution White. It spends a limited time en tirage to retain freshness and finishes drier than Evolution White. Hints of apricot, green apple, bosc pear and white peach with a clean, crisp finish.

Evolution "Lucky No. 9" White Blend, Non-Vintage

Fresh and fruity with a kiss of sweetness and an off-dry finish. Carefully crafted in Oregon with primarily White Riesling, Pinot Gris, Müller-Thurgau, Semillon, Muscat, Gewürztraminer and Chardonnay from Oregon, Washington and California. 91 Points WE & #8 on the top 100 List in 2015.

Evolution 2014 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

A delicious, accessible wine that is 100% Pinot Noir from the Willamette Valley. Stainless steel aged in the presence of oak. 5,100 cases produced.

Evolution "Big Time" Red Blend, Non-Vintage

Bright flavor profile and big, round taste carefully crafted by our winemaking team in Oregon. Blend of Sangiovese, Montepulciano, Syrah and Evolution White with fruit from Oregon, Washington and California. Black cherries, black currants, savory and juicy. 90 Points & Best Buy WE.
