Our **2014 Willamette Valley Pinot Gris** is our signature white wine of Oregon. We press the pinot gris grapes as whole clusters. They are given a slow, cool fermentation in stainless steel, which gives the wine a firm, focused backbone coupled with its lush creaminess. Our Pinot Gris has complex undertones of earth and mineral with expressive notes of floral, citrus and melon.

VINTAGE HIGHLIGHTS

2014 was a warm year and a record-breaking vintage. Due to the long, dry summer and dry harvest conditions, the fruit came in clean and in great condition.

WINEMAKING

Appellation: Willamette Valley

Handpicked, handsorted and whole cluster pressed

Stainless steel tank fermentation for approximately two weeks

Sur lies aged for approximately 3 months

13.5% alcohol by volume | 6,400 cases produced

PAIRINGS

Crab, oysters, halibut, herbed chicken, soft artisan cheeses and fresh fruit.



In 1971, the Sokol Blosser family planted grapes on just five acres in the Dundee Hills. As one of the pioneering wineries of the region, Sokol Blosser has played a key role in developing and shaping the now-prominent Oregon wine industry. The winery is family owned and operated, with the second generation now at the helm: siblings Alex and Alison Sokol Blosser. The estate has grown to more than 86 acres under cultivation, and the winery works to create wines of world-class quality, produced in a sustainable manner, which reflect the distinctive flavors of the grapes, soil and climate.
