Our passion for making world-class wines begins in our vineyards. Originally planted in 1971, our certified organic 89-acre Estate in Oregon has inspired our family for three generations. The geology of the Dundee Hills AVA dates back 15 million years, when lava flowed from northeast Oregon and pushed into the Willamette Valley. This monumental event created the red volcanic Jory soil for which the Dundee Hills AVA is famous.
